Creative Moments

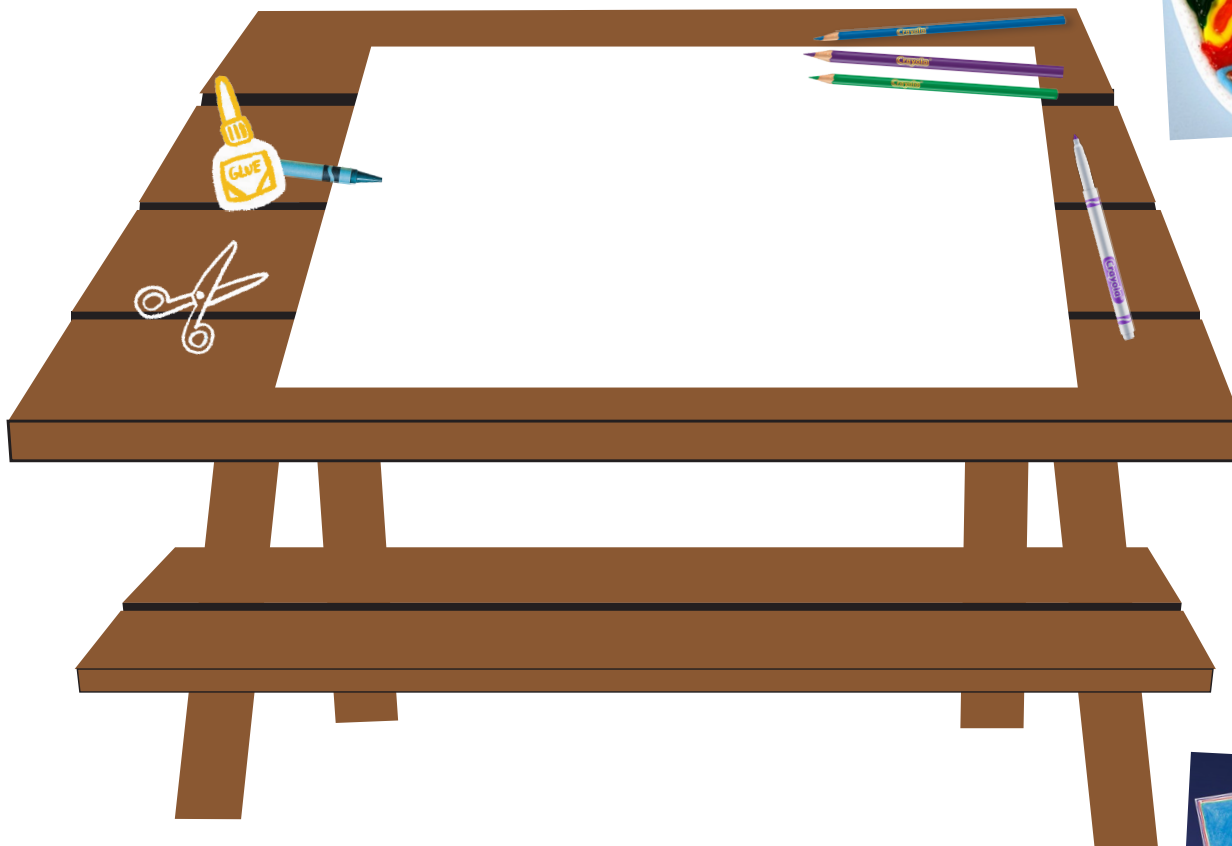
